March *NEWS* from Chamber President Wendy Kernan

March is upon us and I don't know about your company but mine tends to have some turnover this time of year. We all have certain traits we look for; eager to learn, balanced, outspoken (as in will share ideas), team player, integrity, and will of course be that all star. The question is how do you sort that out in an interview? What are some questions that maybe you aren't asking but should? I am going to share some of my best practices and hopefully they will help you with your next interview no matter what position you are hiring for.

- 1) I take our company's values which are Teamwork, Achievement, Passion, and Positive Attitude and align questions around those areas. I want to make sure a candidate is introduced to what is important to us as a company and they will be a good fit with the team we already have in place.
- 2) I ask open ended behavioral questions. What does this mean? It means I tell the candidate to think back to a time, the more recent the better, when they were in the situation I am going to ask them about and walk me through what happened, how they felt, and what the outcome was. (You want to probe for specifics). It is a lot harder for the candidate to fake their way through these types of questions. An example for teamwork would be: "Describe a time when you were part of a team and not everyone was pulling their weight." Achievement: "Tell me about a time where despite your best efforts you just couldn't hit a goal you set out to achieve."
- 3) Make sure you ask the question and give the candidate plenty of time to answer. It is okay to have dead space. Take notice during this time; body language, how do they handle the dead time, are they nervous, or maybe quick to give up and say "I don't know" or "I've never had that happen".
- 4) Make a list of attributes you want, like we did above. Examples: teamwork, multitasker, customer focused, patient. Did their answers show these qualities?
- 5) If in doubt don't be scared to call them back for another interview or to invite them in for a few hours to job shadow.

It is too costly to a business to have a bad hire, so take your time and be sure your candidates fits your business needs.

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
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
