#### Vision

As I was trying to decide what to write about this month and stay true to the Chamber's Vision; it dawned on me what "vision" actually means. Companies spend thousands of dollars on consultants trying to come up with what their company "vision" is going to be. Then more money on marketing and resources trying to get their employees to align with the vision. Smaller businesses do not have these resources and set their vision when they are doing their business plan, and then leave it to sit on a shelf gathering dust.

I am going to challenge everyone with a business to dust off that old plan and take a peek inside. How far are you from your original vison? Don't have a business: Then let's create one for yourself; the principals are the same. You don't have to overthink it, but you do need to take a few minutes to create something powerful that can move you forward to the next step, either in your career or with your company. Here is how I break down vision into some simple steps/processes:

- **Create:** Create a powerful vision for yourself or your company that is full of passion, emotion, and desire. Make sure it includes what you or your business is good at. How do you see yourself; or better yet, how do you want others to see you or your business?
- Identify: Identify what you love to do, what is easy, effortless, and enjoyable to do. What is easy for you to excel at? What comes naturally? What does your business do without having to spend a lot of \$\$ promoting it, just seems to "walk in the door", or what part of your business is stable/steady that you can count on?
- **Become:** Become excellent at what you do well. Build on the foundation.
- Stop: Stop doing what you don't do well. Another way to think of it is to know your lane; once you know it, work on owning it. Build your brand. I see a lot of business that change their model a lot which does not stay true to their initial/root business. They think they can make an extra dollar if they "added this on". An example would be a car repair going into the coffee business or using their extra space for fitness classes (you might go what? Trust me if you look around you will see something similar). This pulls resources away from what you are good at, and it can cause you will fail at both. On an individual level, it will leave not liking what you do, it's hard to go into work, you lack passion, and you do it just for the paycheck. Well STOP! Life is too short.
- **Keep:** Keep challenging yourself and those around you to be excellent at what you do. (Which is easy when you know what you do and what you are good at.)

Capture all that in a sentence or two and keep it front and center. As new opportunities present themselves look at your vision and let it guide you.
