Fee: Early Bird Non-Member \$375 or Early Bird Member \$200 per booth space, if registered by Feb. 1, 2023.

After Feb. 1, 2023 booth space will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis at

Non-Member Price of \$425 or Member Price \$250 Registration Form & Payment Due by March 17, 2023.

(Non-member price for both Early Bird and non-Early Bird includes a free membership.)

- All Early Bird booth contracts and checks must be received by Feb. 1, 2023 to retain a discounted booth space.
- All exhibitors must restrict their exhibit to the business registered with the Mt. Zion Chamber of Commerce. All multiple businesses that are Chamber members, must register each business they wish to exhibit.
- Doors will be open for setup on Friday, March 31, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

All exhibitors are to be set up by 5:00 p.m.

- Exhibitors will unload in the front and park to the immediate north & east of the Convention Center on April 1, 2023.
- Exhibitors will **NOT** remove their display before 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 1, 2023.
- Exhibitors will NOT sell any illegal items.
- Exhibitors will remove all trash, paper, boxes, tape, etc. from their space.
- Exhibitors will cooperate with all requests of show personnel.
- Exhibitors MUST keep display within confines of their space and not go into the aisles.
- The Mt. Zion Chamber of Commerce or the Mt. Zion Convention Center will not be held liable for any losses, damages or injuries sustained by exhibitors in any manner whatsoever.
- No refunds or credits for cancellations for any reason after March 17, 2023.
- Exhibitors will be supplied (1) table, (2) chairs, table cloth, pipe and drape on three sides. You must supply extension cords and display accessories. Wall booth spaces are for booths that need electrical outlets. Electrical Booth space will be available to those who pay the \$25.00 fee.
